FYI: The Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program offers guaranteed admission to California community college students who have met all program requirements a full term prior to transferring to UCSD.

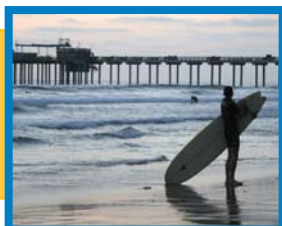
More than 90% of transfer students at UC San Diego come from a California community college.

TAG Program Highlights *for the 2010-2011 academic year*

- includes all California community colleges
- offered for Fall-quarter transfers only
- submit your UC application
 - filing period deadline: November 1-30, 2009
 - on the application:
 - the IGETC box
 - the UCSD TAG box (must check both boxes)
 - rank your UCSD college choices—TAG doesn't guarantee your choice

California community college students can participate in this guaranteed program by:

1. submitting the application
2. meeting all requirements:
 - cumulative 3.0 minimum UC GPA
 - complete both of the UC English courses and the UC math course by the end of Fall 2009 prior to Fall 2010 admission
 - Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)
 - full completion of IGETC is required
 - courses completed by end of Spring 2010
 - submit your IGETC certification form by July 15

Who's Eligible?

TAG is available to U.S. citizens, permanent residents, AB540 students, and former UC students in good standing (except former UC San Diego students).

Qualifications

To qualify for TAG, you need to be a California community college student:

- enrolled at one or more CCCs for at least 2 regular terms
- completed at least 30 semester (45 quarter) UC-transferable units at a CCC
- attended a CCC as your last college before UC San Diego admission
- in good standing during your last regular term
- will be applying for junior status

Program Requirements

- Full certification of IGETC is required.
- See all program requirements and the optional UC TAG form on the UC San Diego Admissions website

- ASSIST is an online student transfer information system that shows how course credits earned at your college or university can be applied when transferred to another:

Unit Requirements and Limitations

- You need 60 UC-transferable semester units (or 90 UC-transferable quarter units) to transfer at the junior level.
- If you have 90 or more semester (or 135+ quarter units) from accredited four-year universities and community colleges combined, then you are defined as having senior class standing. TAG does not apply in this case.
- You cannot reach senior standing with community college units only. A maximum of 70 semester or 105 quarter UC-transferable community college units will be accepted toward graduation. For CCC units above these limits, subject credit is awarded.
- Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate units earned prior to high school graduation do not apply to the unit limit.
